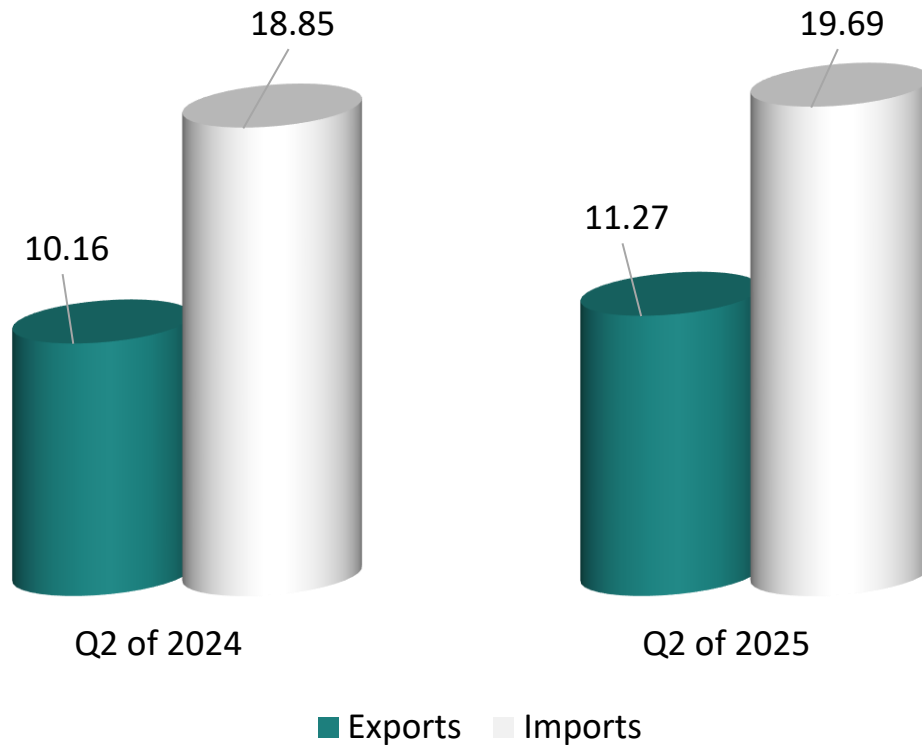

(USD billion)



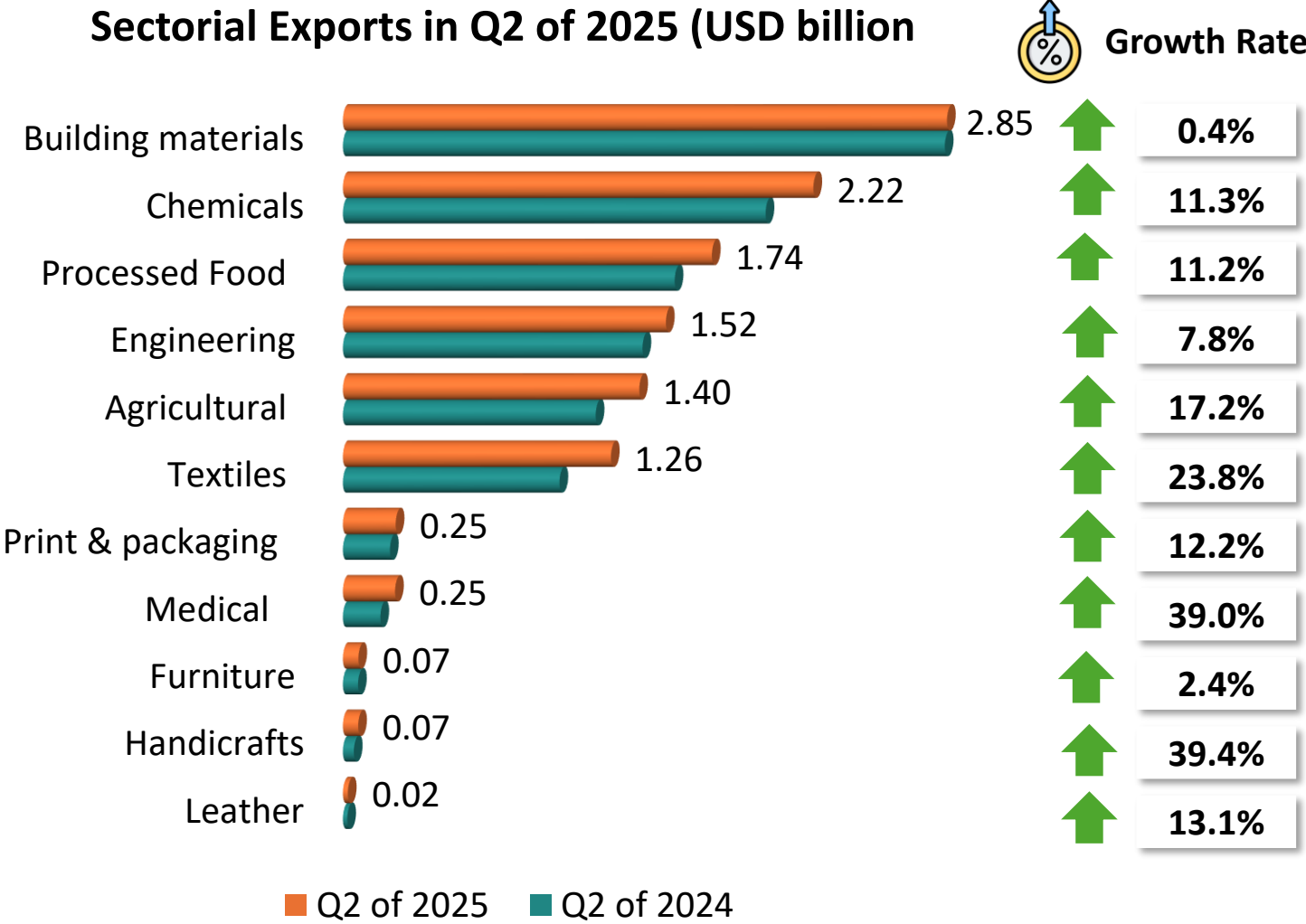
Exports Growth Rate
in Q2 of 2025



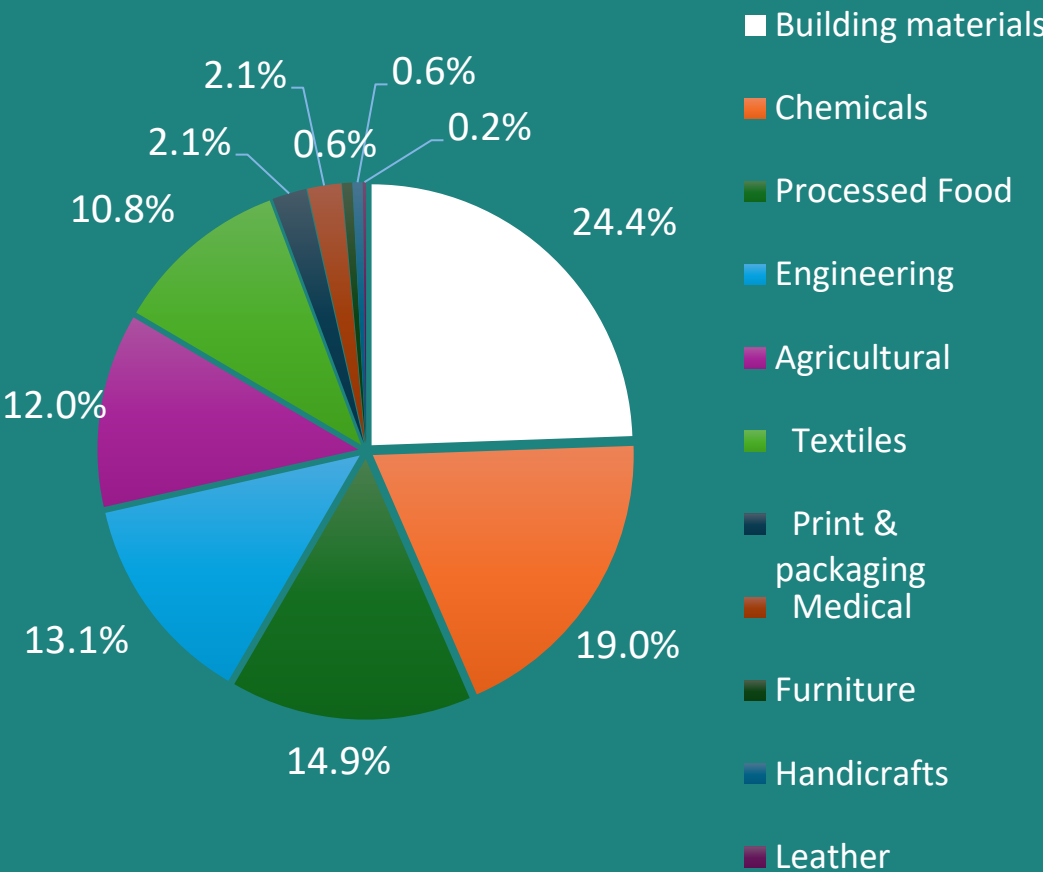
Imports Decline Rate

Sectorial Exports in Q2 of 2025 (USD billion)

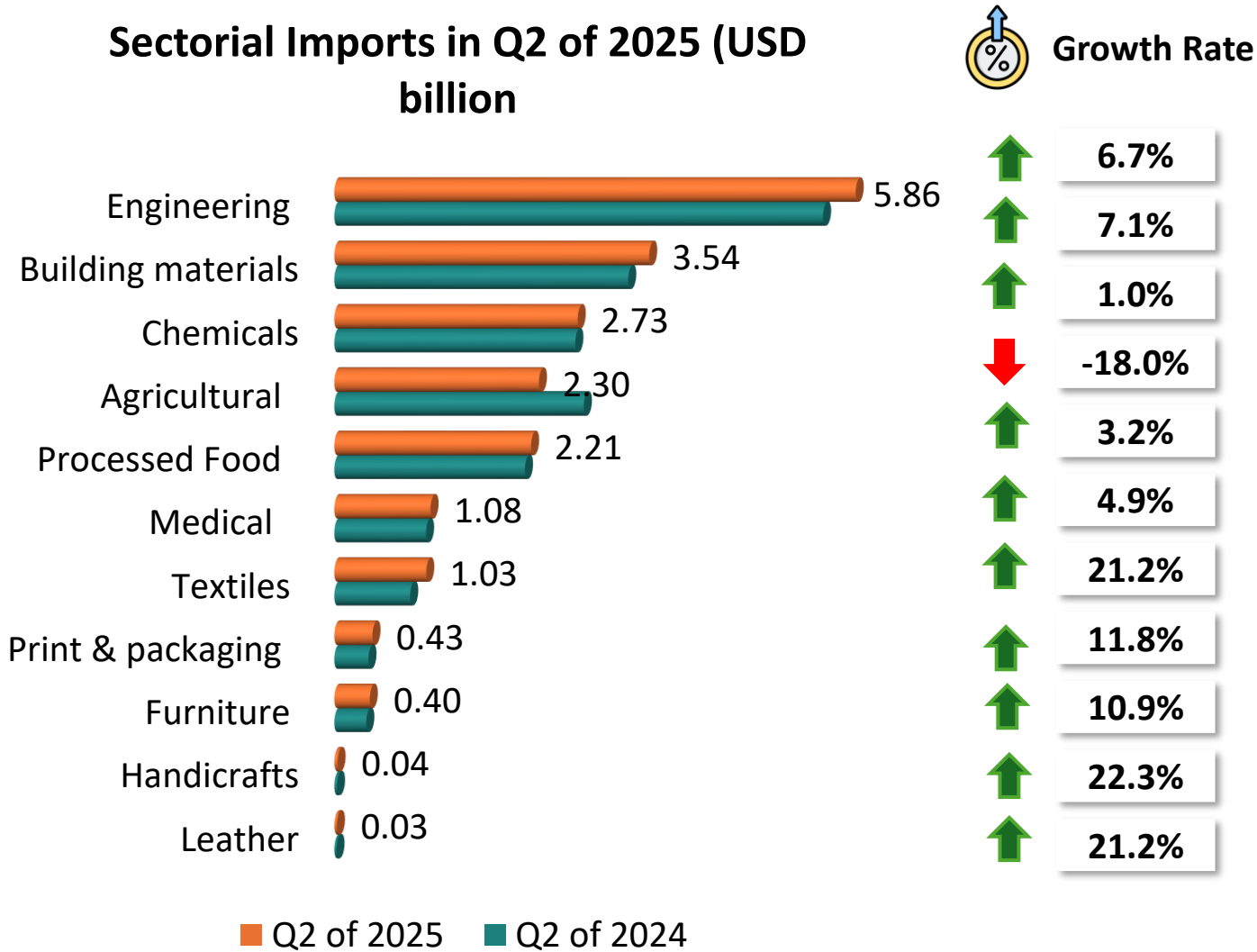


Share from Total Exports in Q2 of 2025

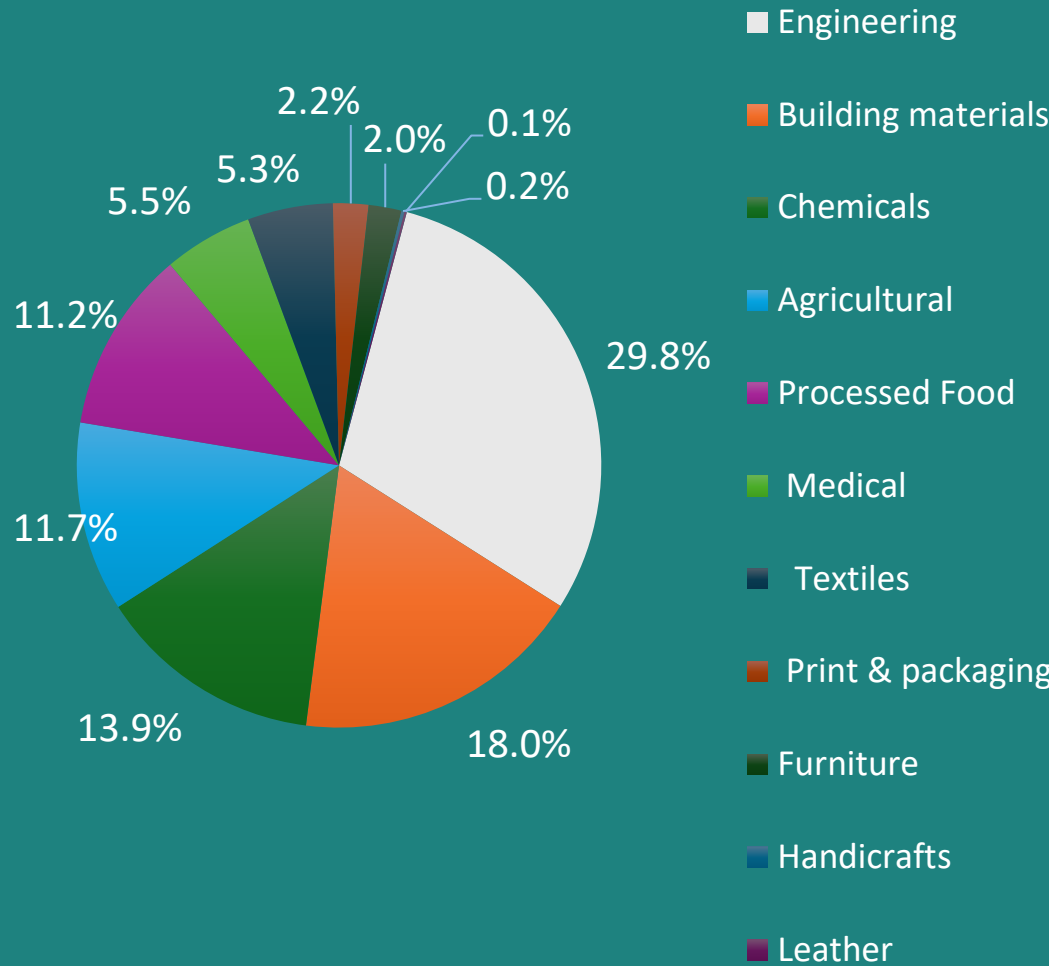

Sectorial Imports in Q2 of 2025 (USD billion)

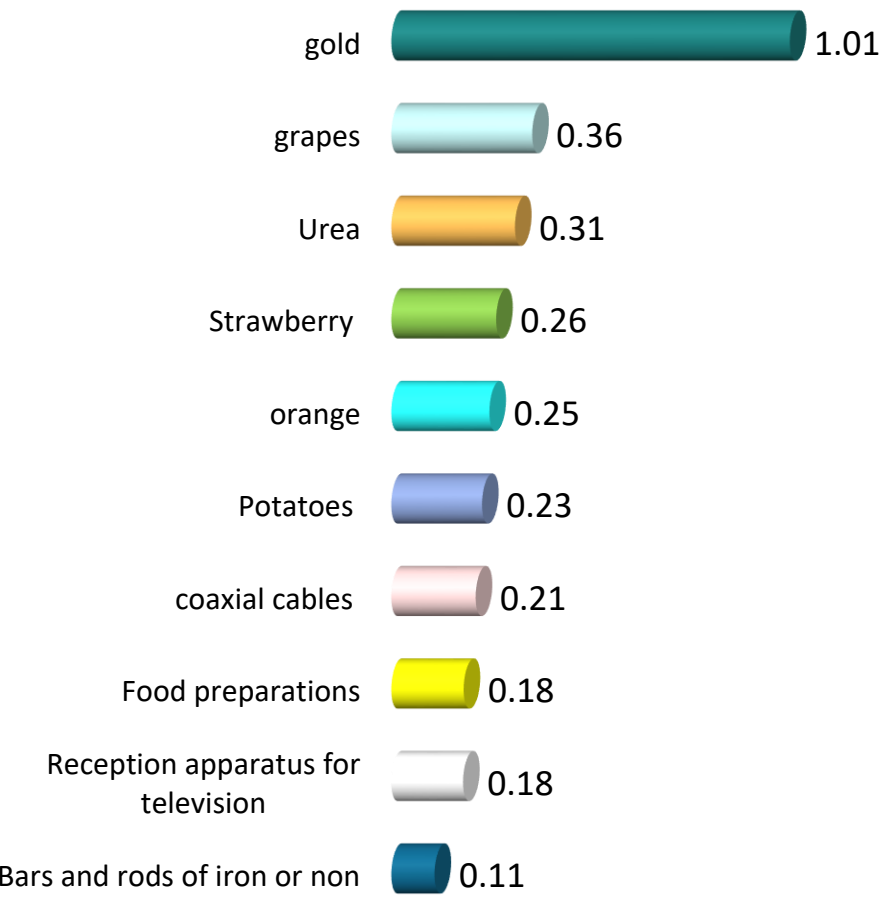


Share from Total Imports in Q2 of 2025

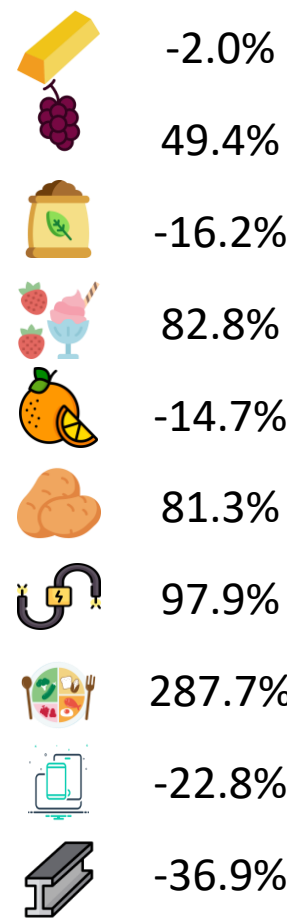

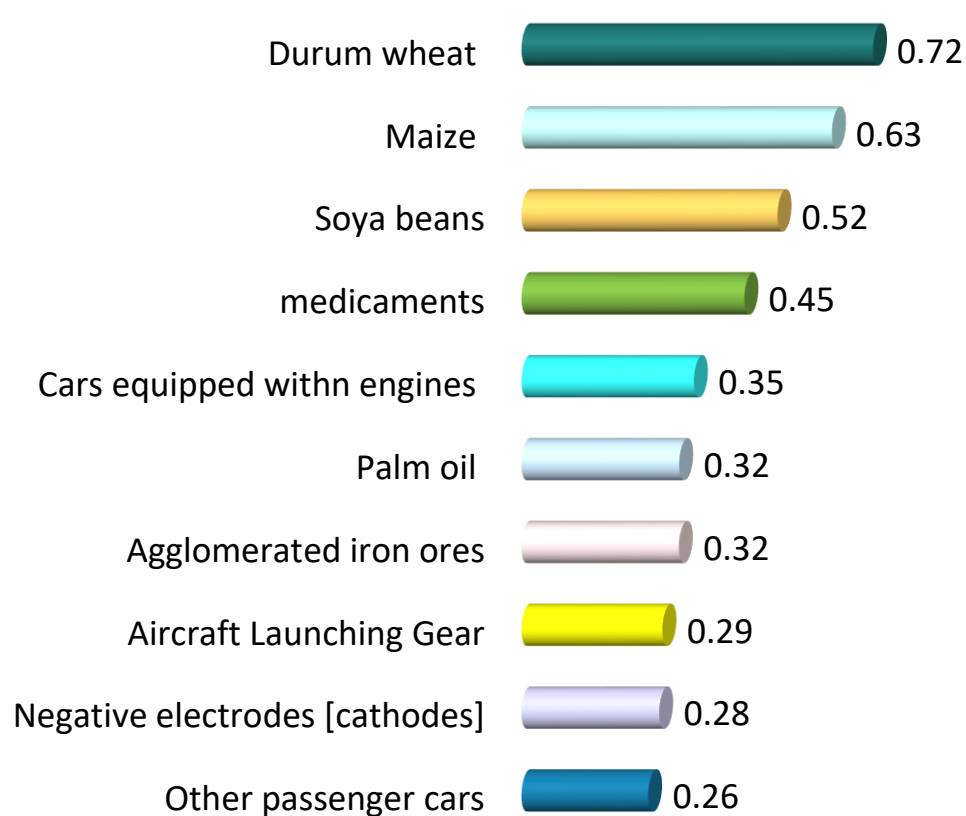

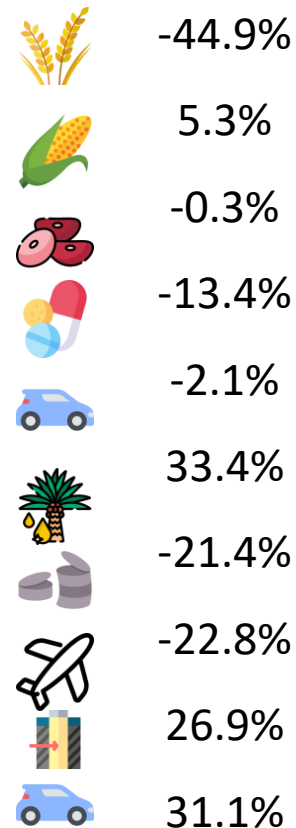

Top Imported Products in Q2 of 2025 (USD billion)



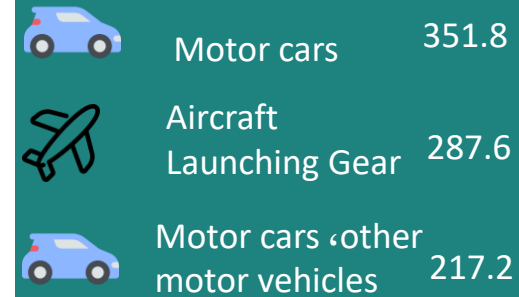
Growth Rate Q2 of (2024 –2025)

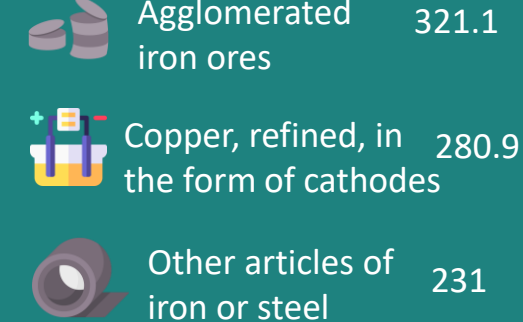

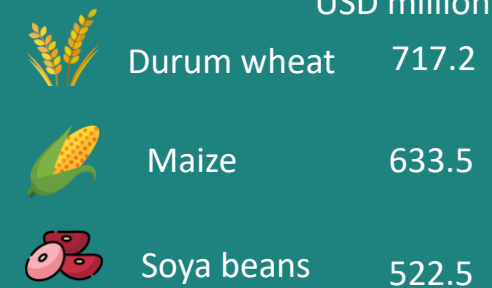

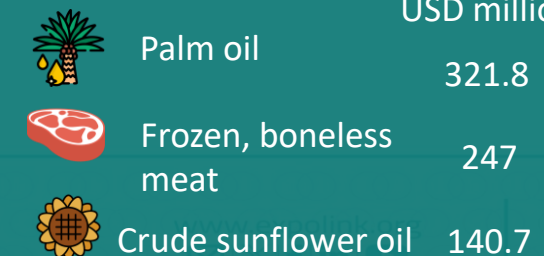

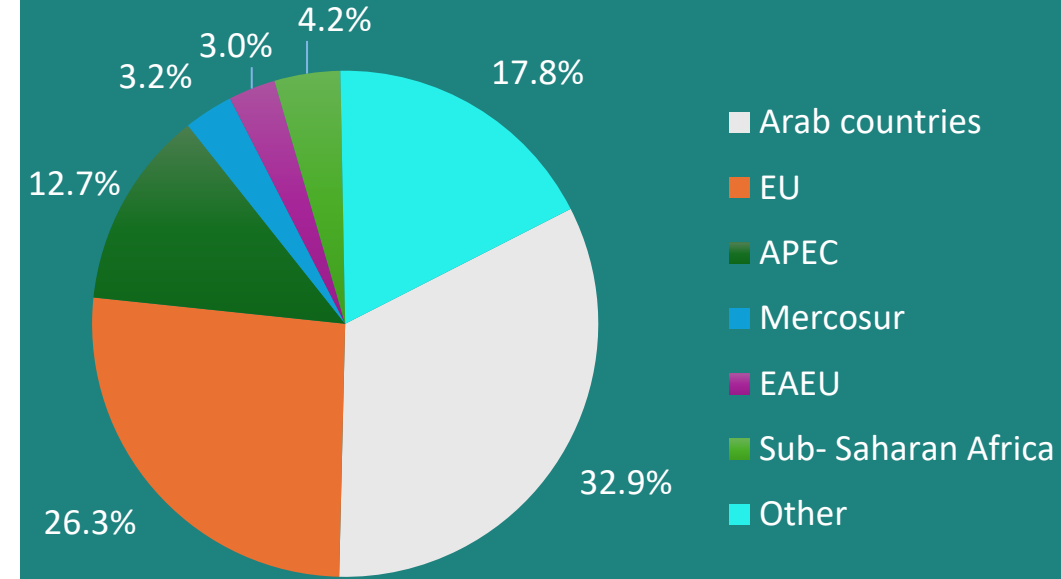

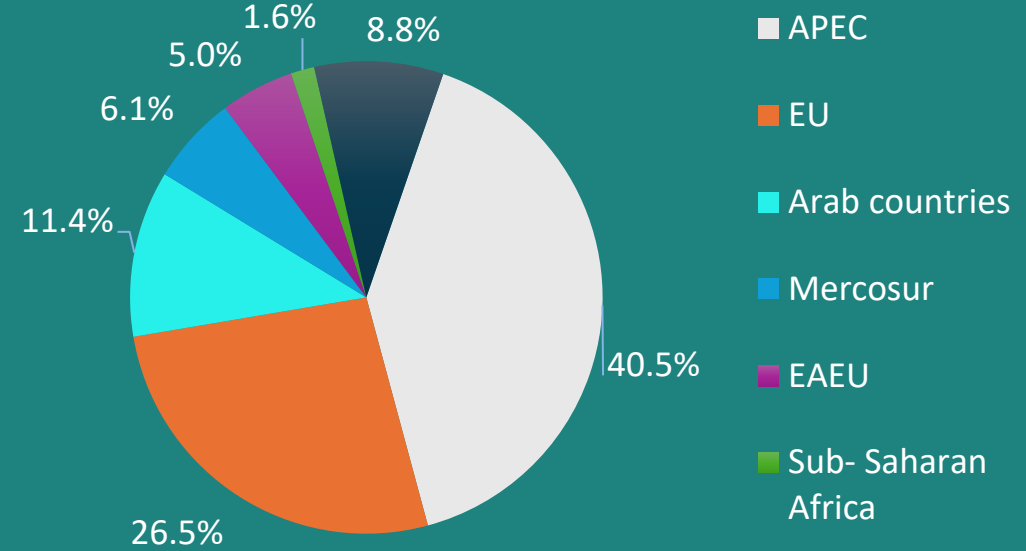

TOP IMPORTERS FROM EGYPT IN Q2 OF 2025



Gold (68.3%) and Reception apparatus for television (5.6%) are **United Arab Emirates'** top imported products from Egypt with a value of USD 605 million, and USD 49 million, respectively.



Turkey mainly imported Urea (10.1%) and Polypropylene (5.9%) from Egypt in Q2 of 2025 with a value of USD 87 million, and USD 51 million, respectively.



Men's or boys' T-shirt of synthetic fibers (7.6%) and trousers from cotton (6.6%) are **USA's** top imported product from Egypt in Q2 of 2025 with a value of USD 53 million, and USD 47 million, respectively.

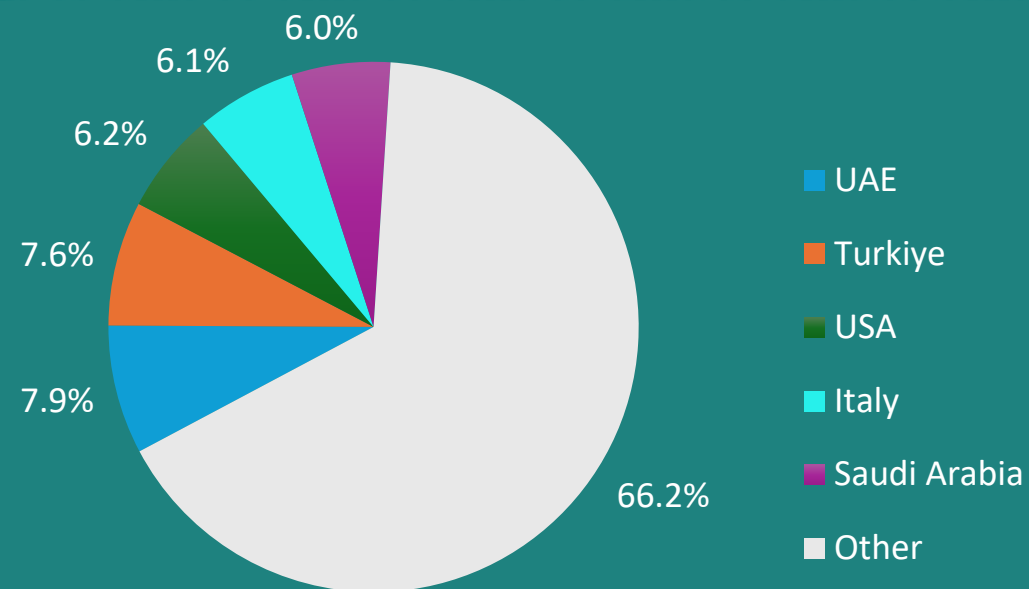


kerosene (13.7%) and Urea (7.4%) are **Italy's** top imported products from Egypt in Q2 of 2025 with a value of USD 94 million, and USD 51 million, respectively.



Saudi Arabia's top imported products from Egypt were wire of refined copper (10.2%), and T-shirts, singlets and other vests of cotton (6.8%) with a value of USD 69 million, and USD 46 million, respectively.

TOP EXPORERS TO EGYPT IN Q2 of 2025



The top imported products from **China** are Iron or steel products (4.2%), and Flat Panel of Display Modules (2.6%) with a value of USD 163 million, and USD 102 million, respectively.



The top imported products from **USA** Soya Beans (36.8%) and Bituminous Coal (9.8%) with a value of USD 372 million, and USD 99 million, respectively



The top imported products from **Belgium** were Medicaments (8%) and Aircraft Launching Gear (6.3%) with a value of USD 80 million, and USD 63 million, respectively.

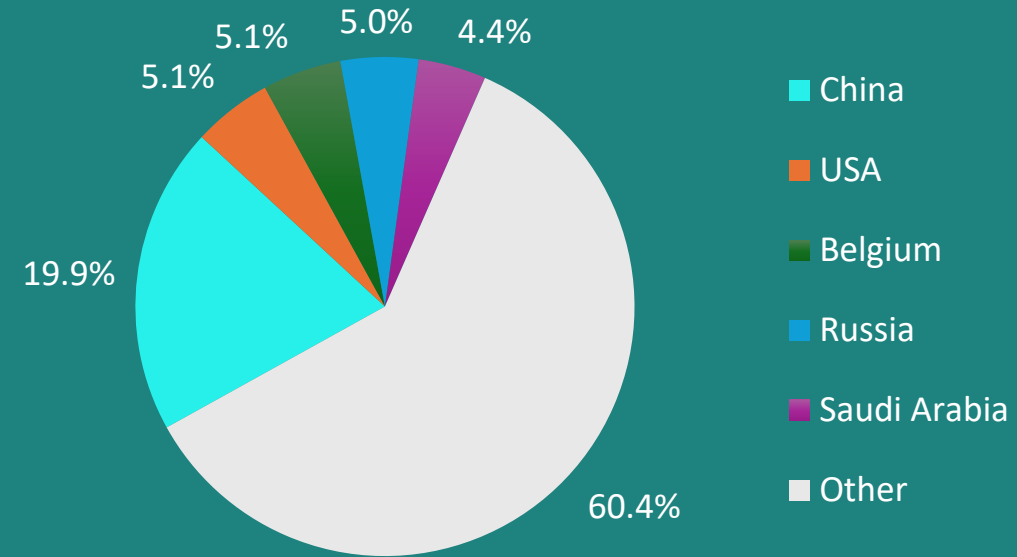


Egypt's top imported products from **Russia** are Durum Wheat (39.8%), and Semi-Finished Products of Iron or Non-Alloy Steel (14.9%) with a value of USD 395 million, and USD 148 million, respectively.
