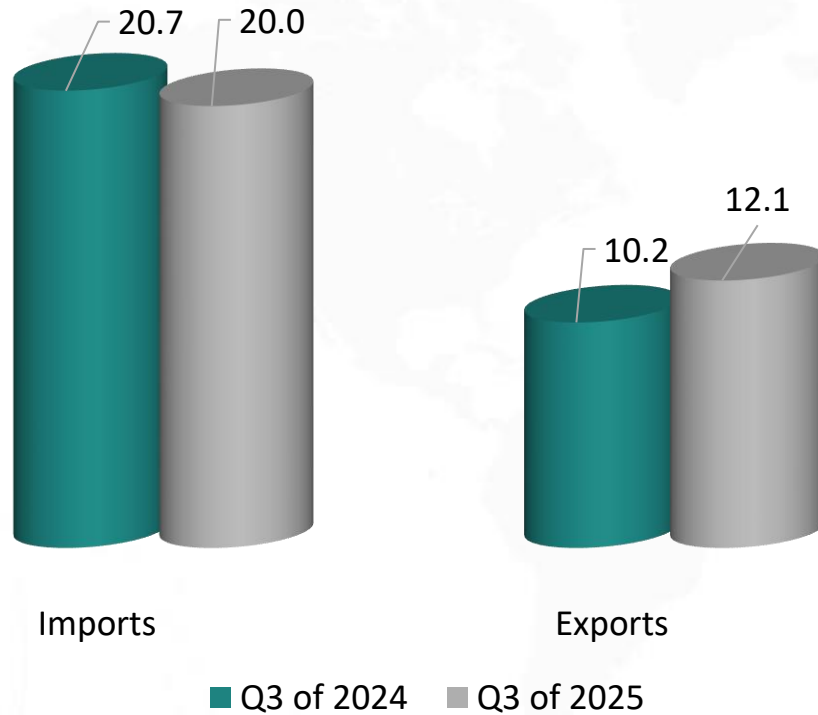

in Q3 of 2025



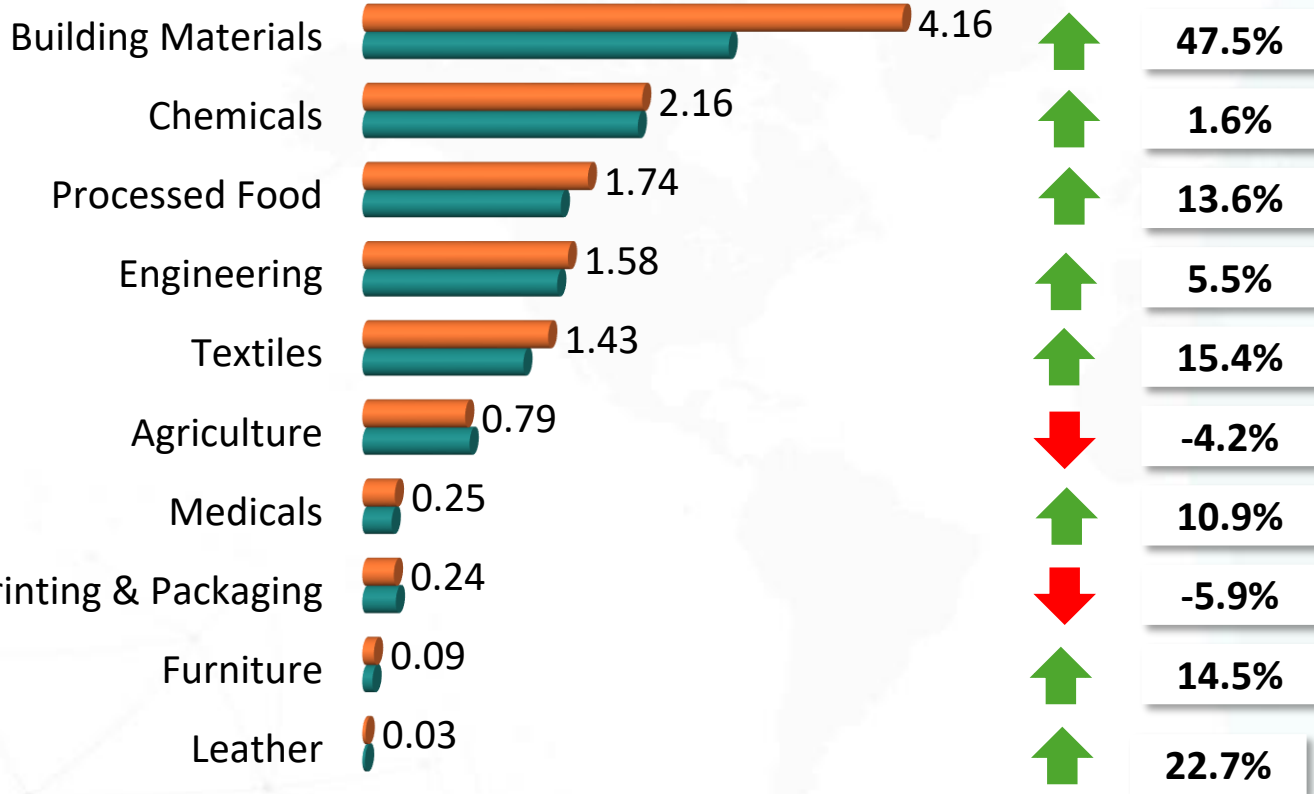
Imports Decline Rate

Sectorial Exports in Q3 of 2025 (USD billion)

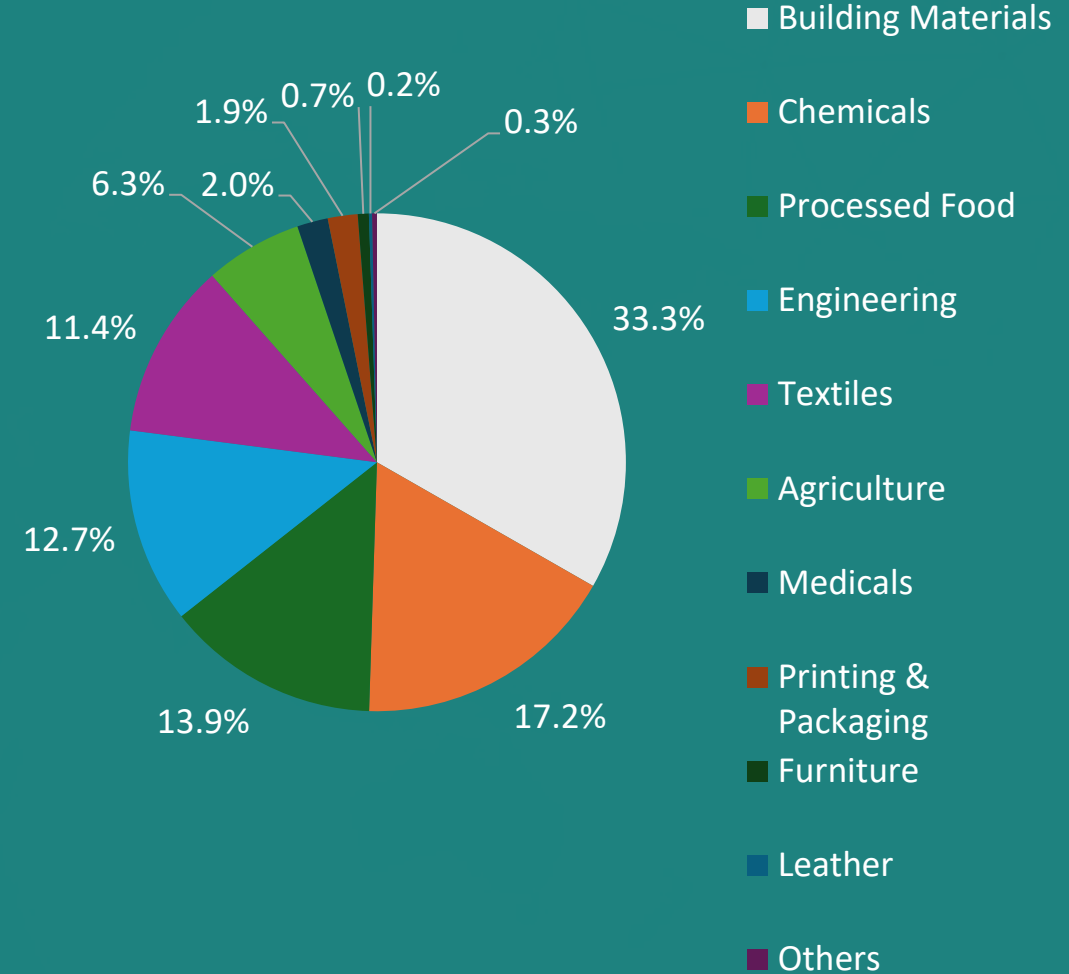


Annual Growth Rate

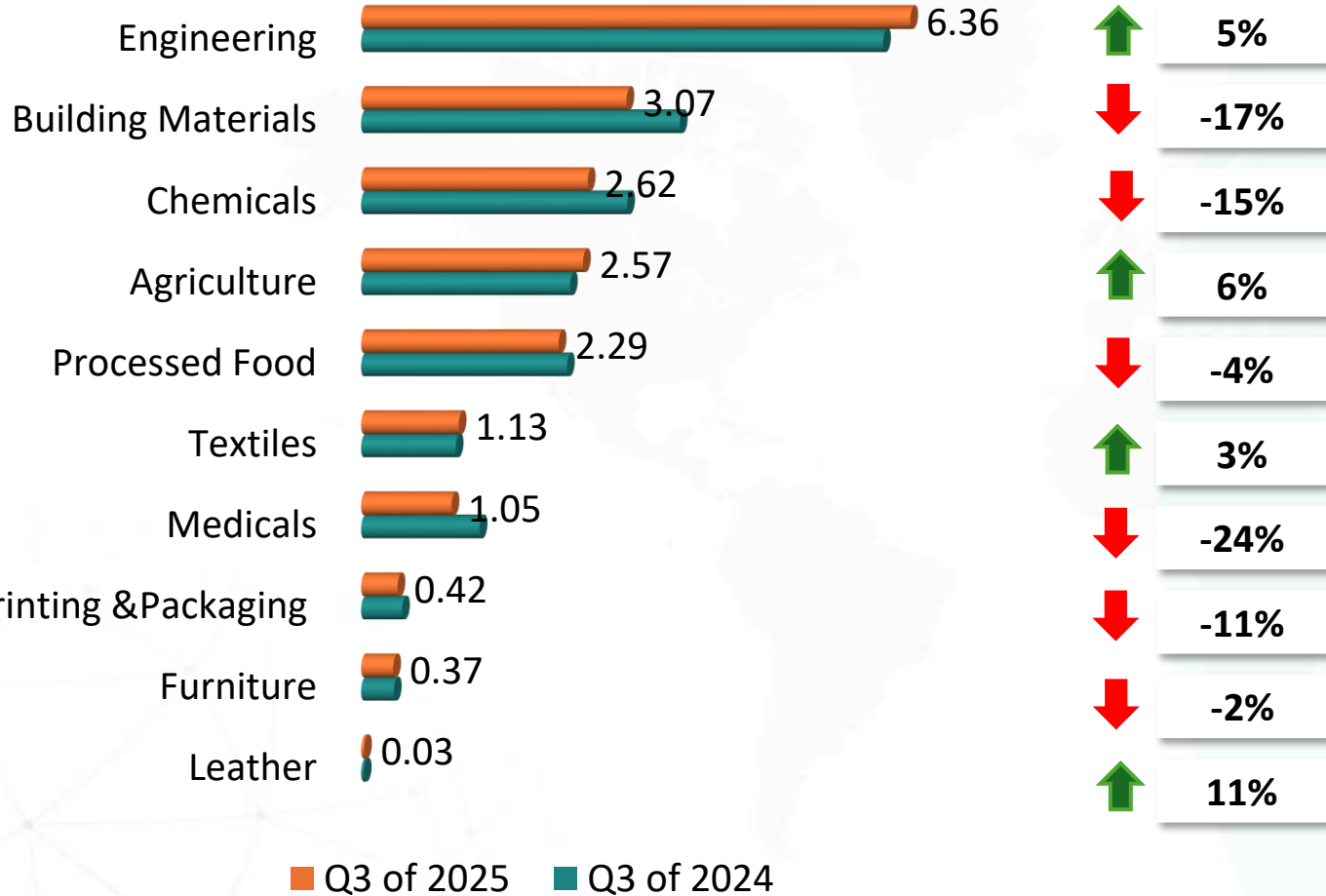

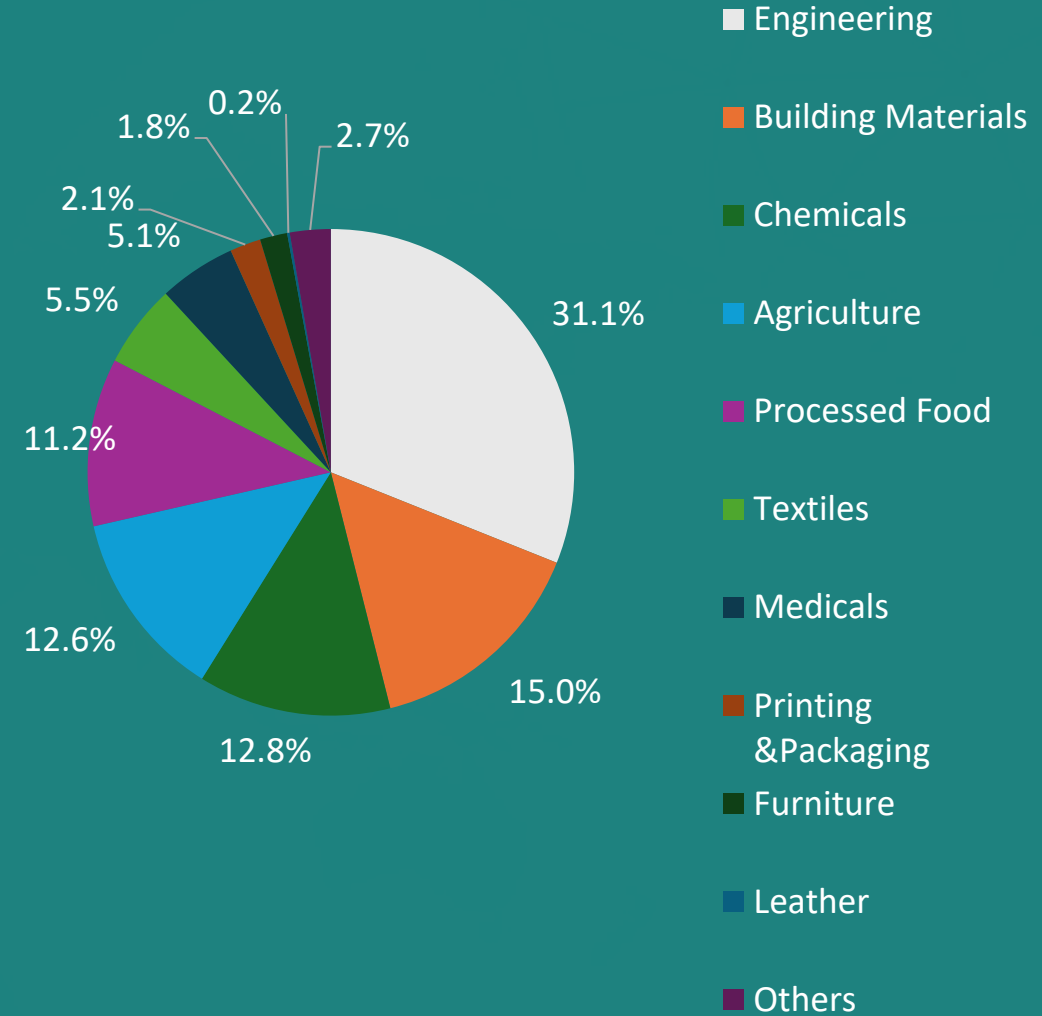
Sectorial Imports in Q3 of 2025 (USD billion)

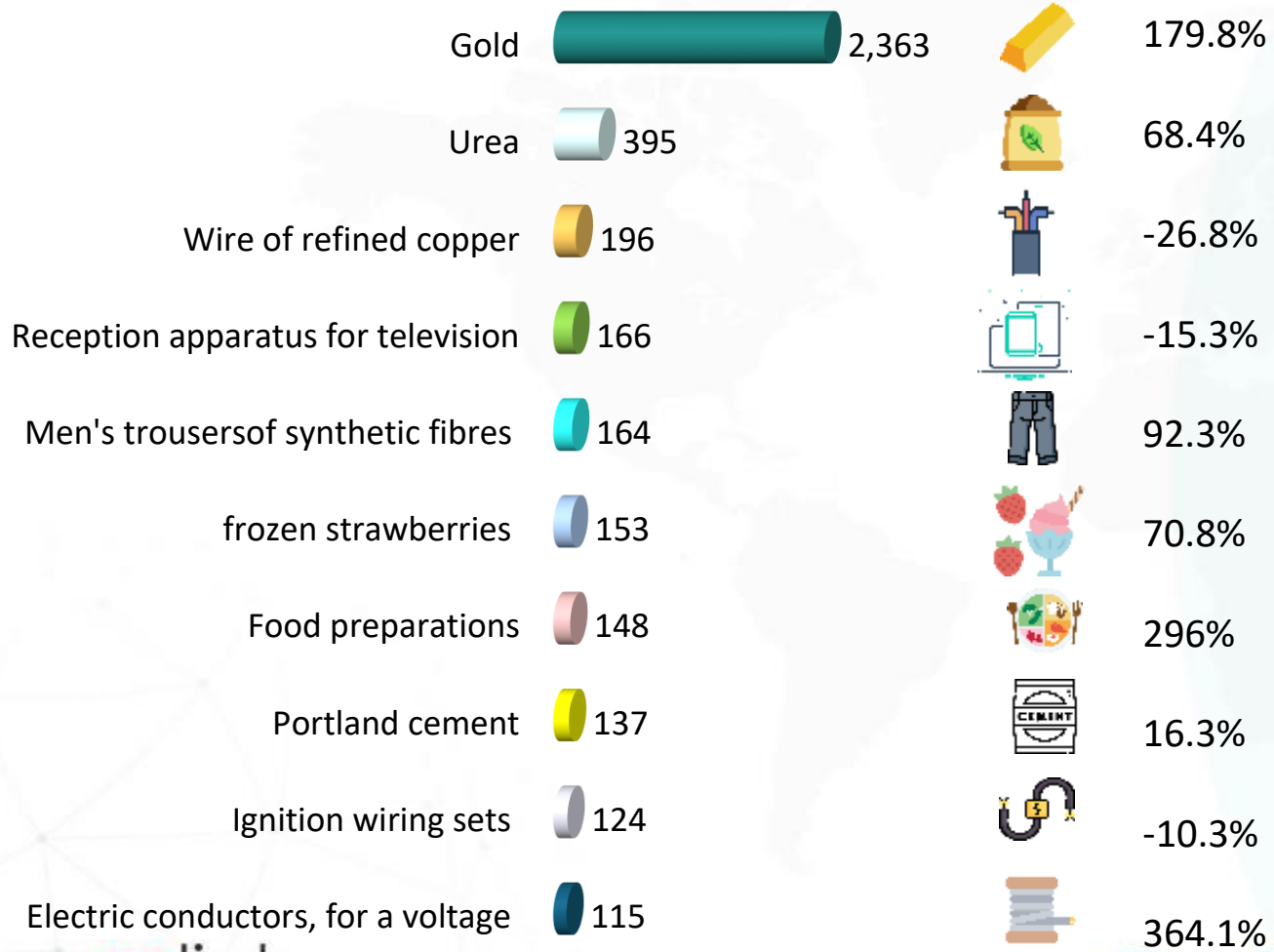


Share from Total Imports in Q3 of 2025

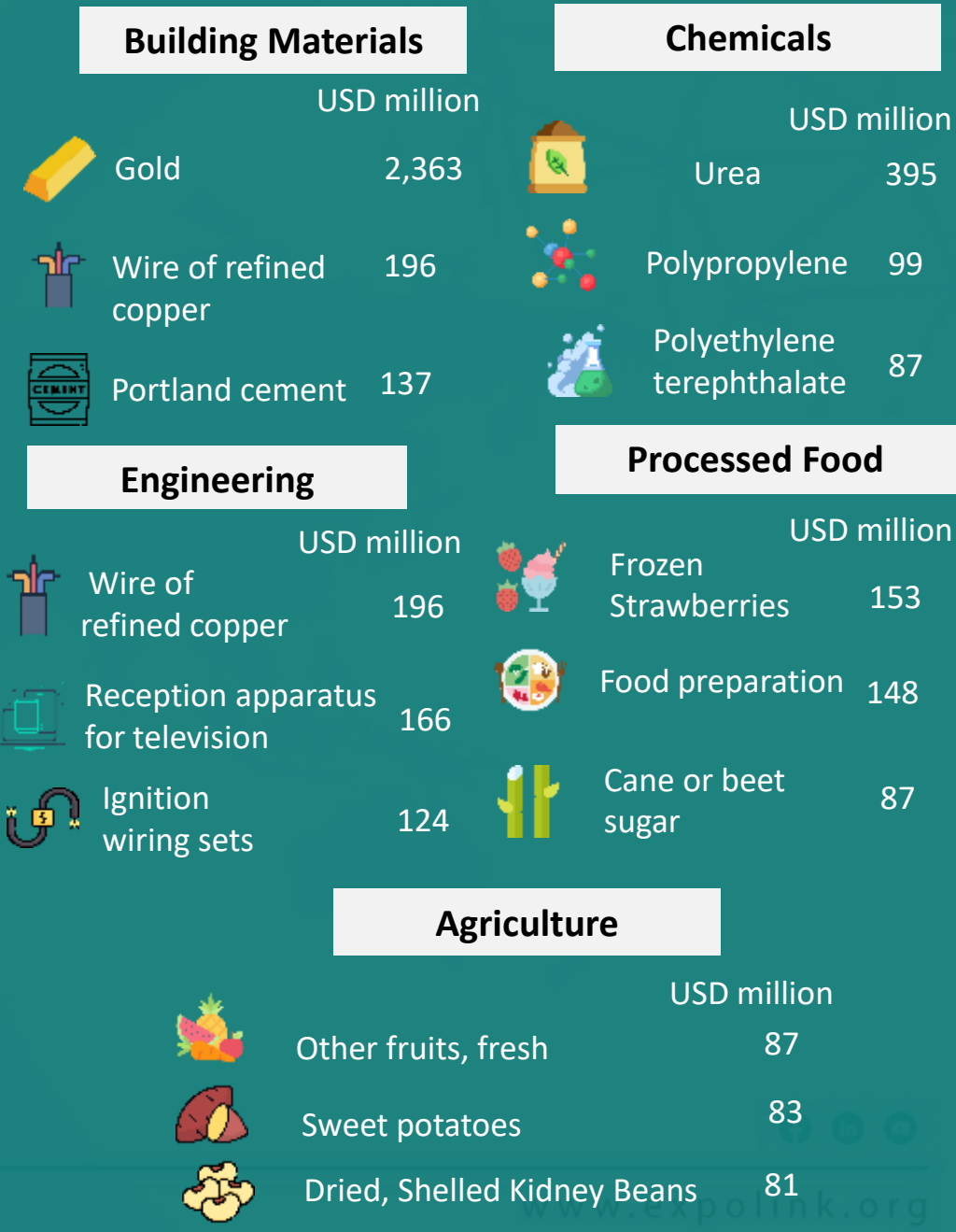

Top Exported Products in Q3 of 2025 (USD million)

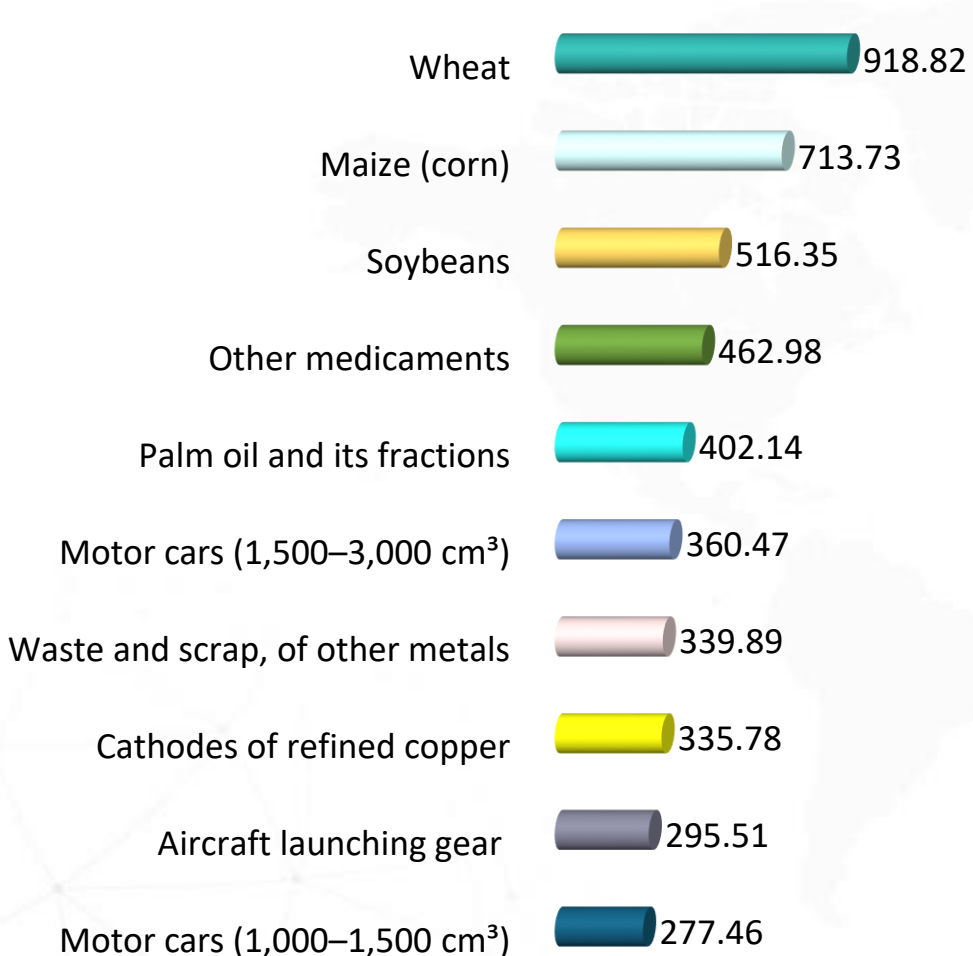


Top Exported Products in the Top 5 Sectors

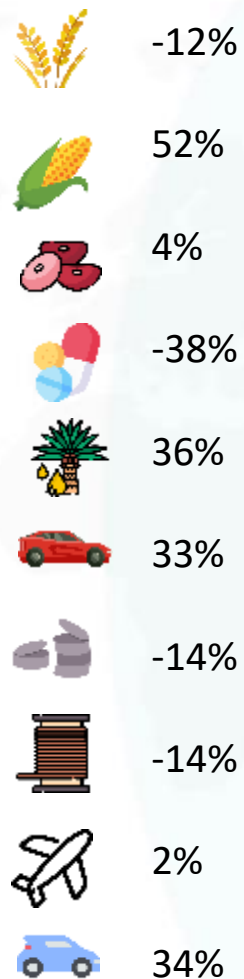

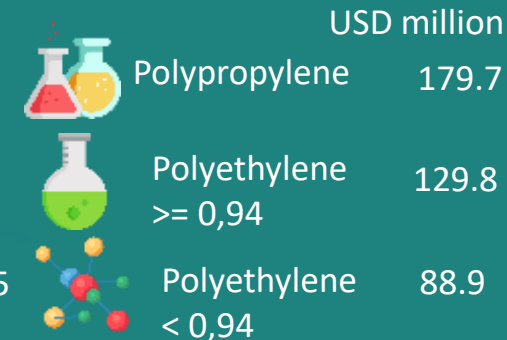

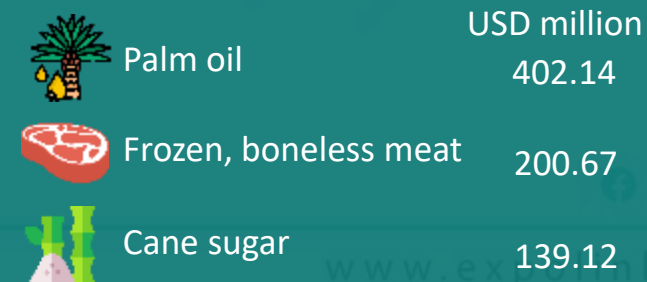

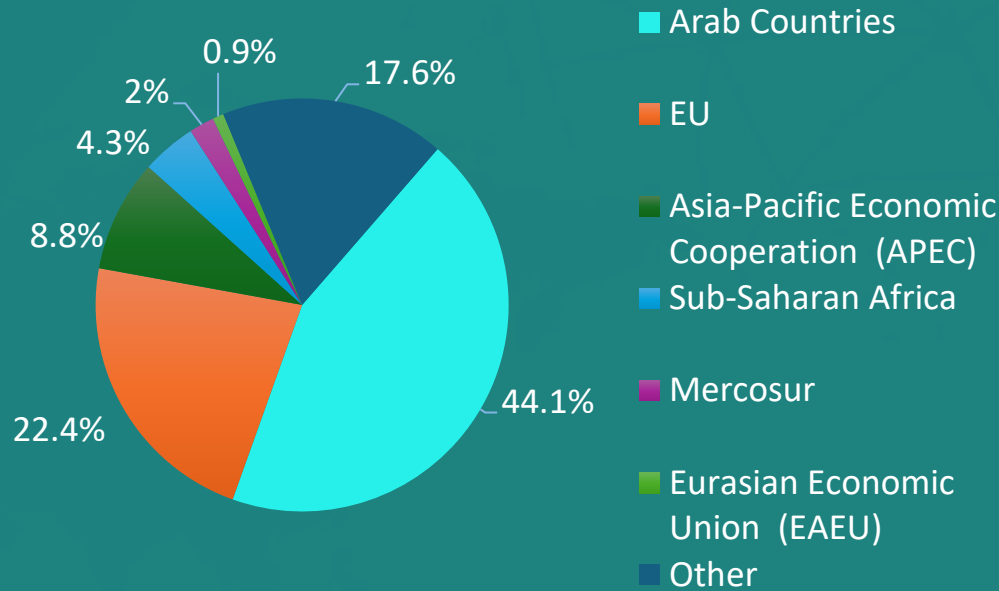

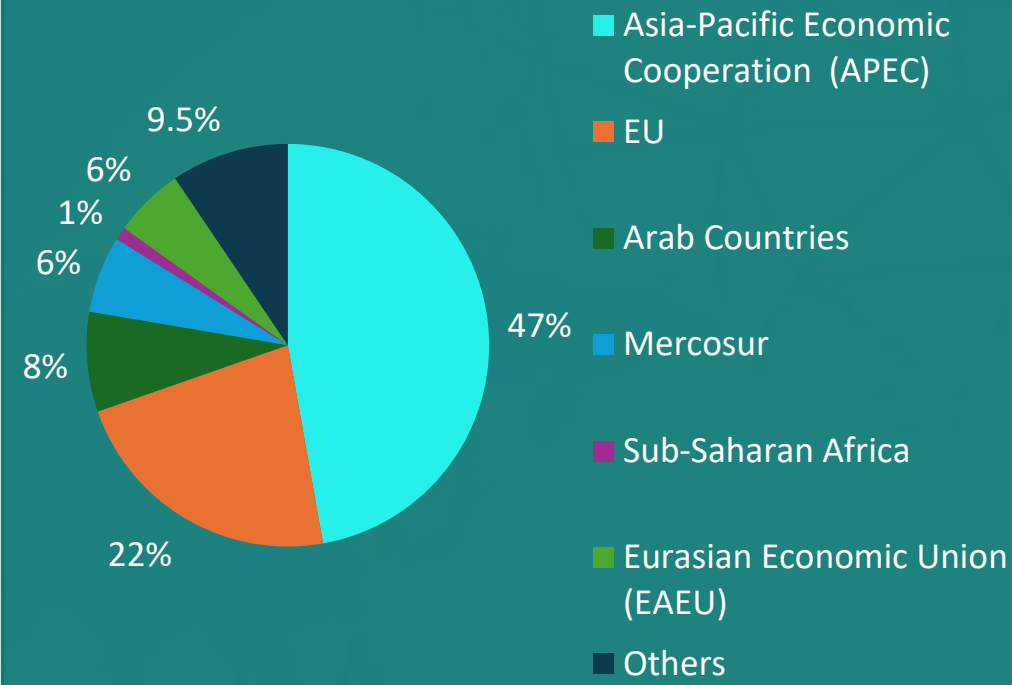

TOP IMPORTERS FROM EGYPT IN Q3 OF 2025



Gold (86%) and fresh pomegranate (1.8%) are **United Arab Emirates'** top imported products from Egypt with value of USD 1.84 billion, and USD 0.039 billion, respectively.



Saudi Arabia's top imported products from Egypt were wire of refined copper (11.4%), and men's trousers of synthetic fibres (8.7%) with value of USD 86 million, and USD 66 million, respectively.



Turkiye mainly imported urea (7.4%) and Polypropylene (6.3%) from Egypt in Q3 of 2025 with value of USD 55 million, and USD 47 million, respectively.

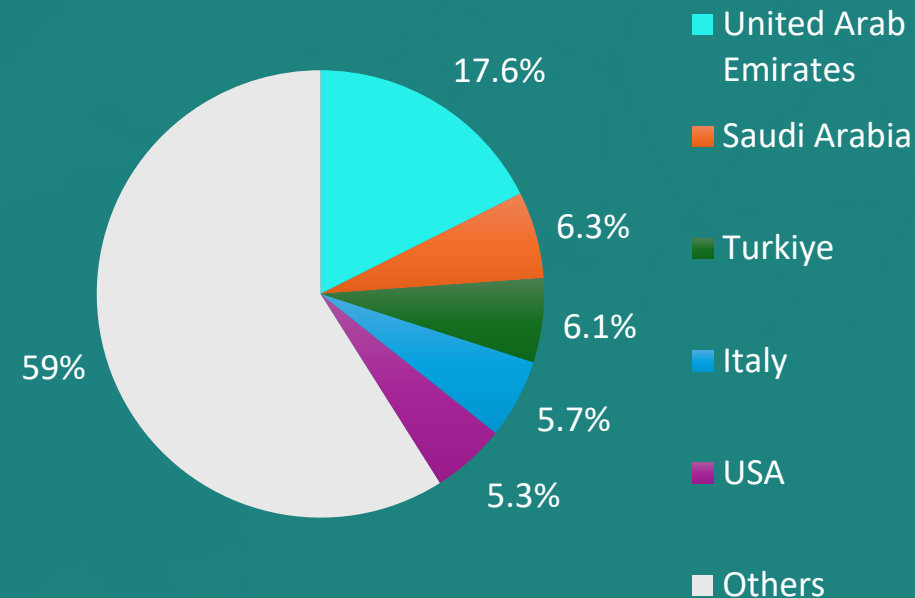


Aluminum (5.8%) and Aluminum panels, strips (5.4%) are **Italy's** top imported products from Egypt in Q3 of 2025 with value of USD 40 million, and USD 34 million, respectively.



T-shirts, singlets and other vests of textile (9.4%) and men's or boys' trousers of synthetic fibers (6.7%) are **USA's** top imported product from Egypt in Q3 of 2025 with value of USD 61 million, and USD 43 million, respectively.

TOP EXPORERS TO EGYPT IN Q3 OF 2025



The top imported products from **China** are parts of telephone sets (4%), and motor cars (1300-1500 cm3) (2%) with a value of USD 206 million, and USD 112 million, respectively.



Egypt's top imported products from **USA** are soya beans (31%), and aircraft launching gear (11%) with value of USD 428 million, and USD 154 million, respectively.



The top imported products from **Germany** were road tractors for semi-trailers (10%) and medicaments (8%) with value of USD 117 million, and USD 96 million, respectively.

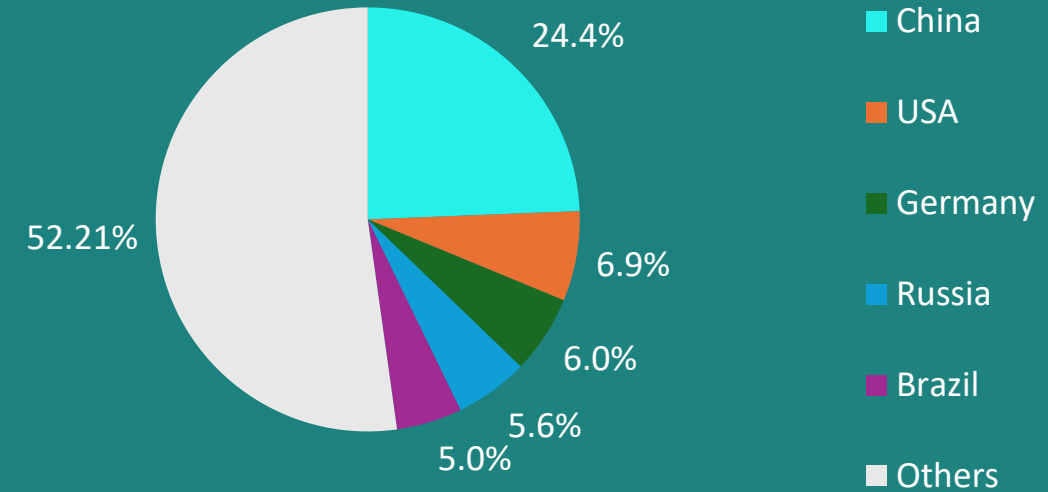


The top imported products from **Russia** are durum wheat (39%) and copper, refined (19%) with value of USD 440 million, and USD 215 million, respectively
