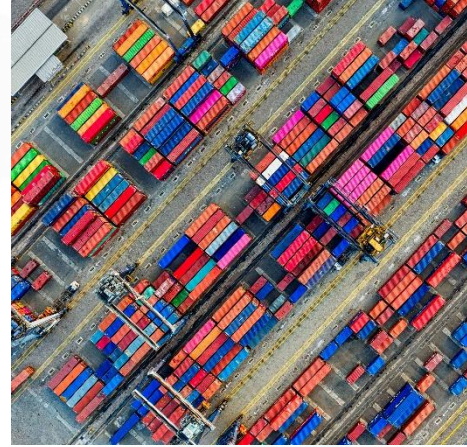

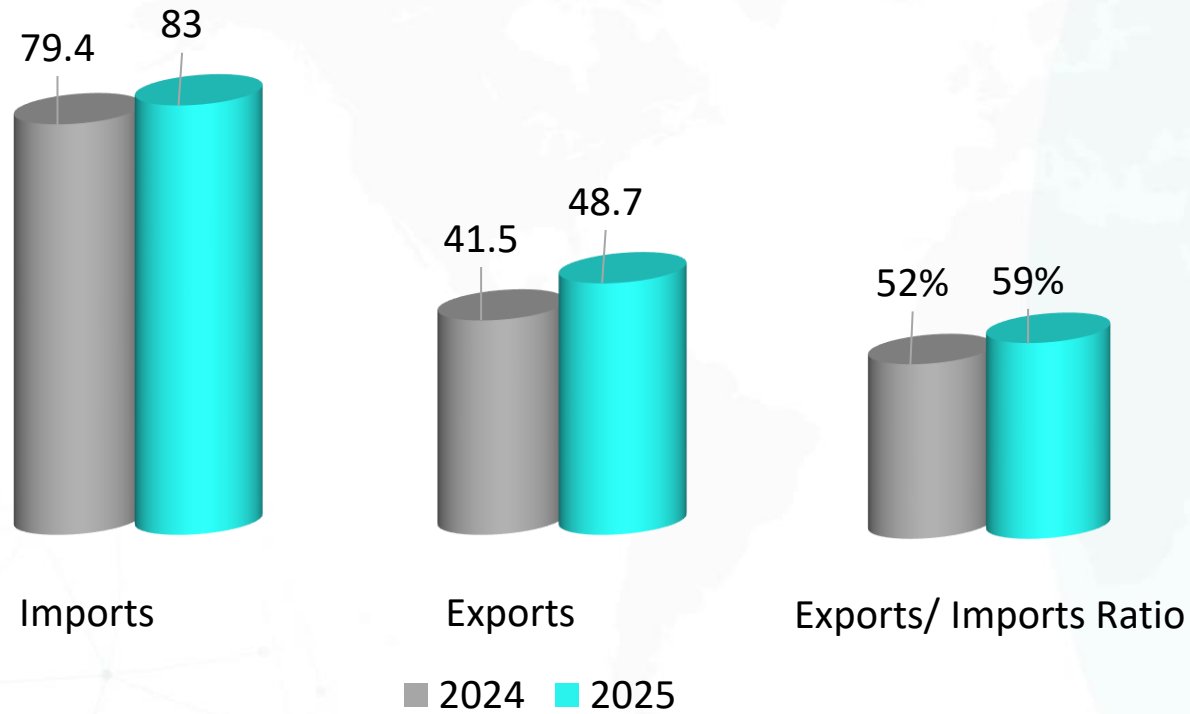

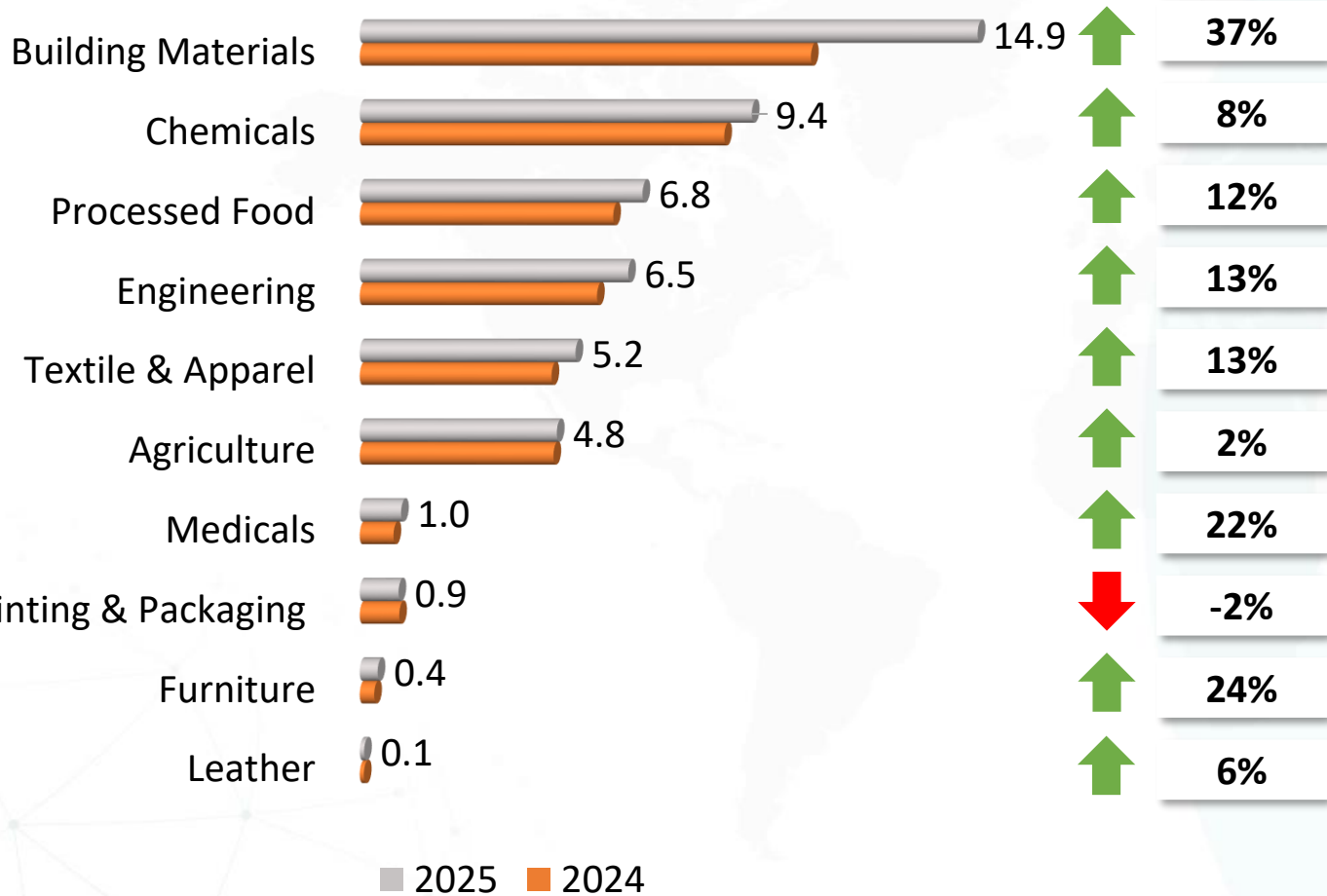

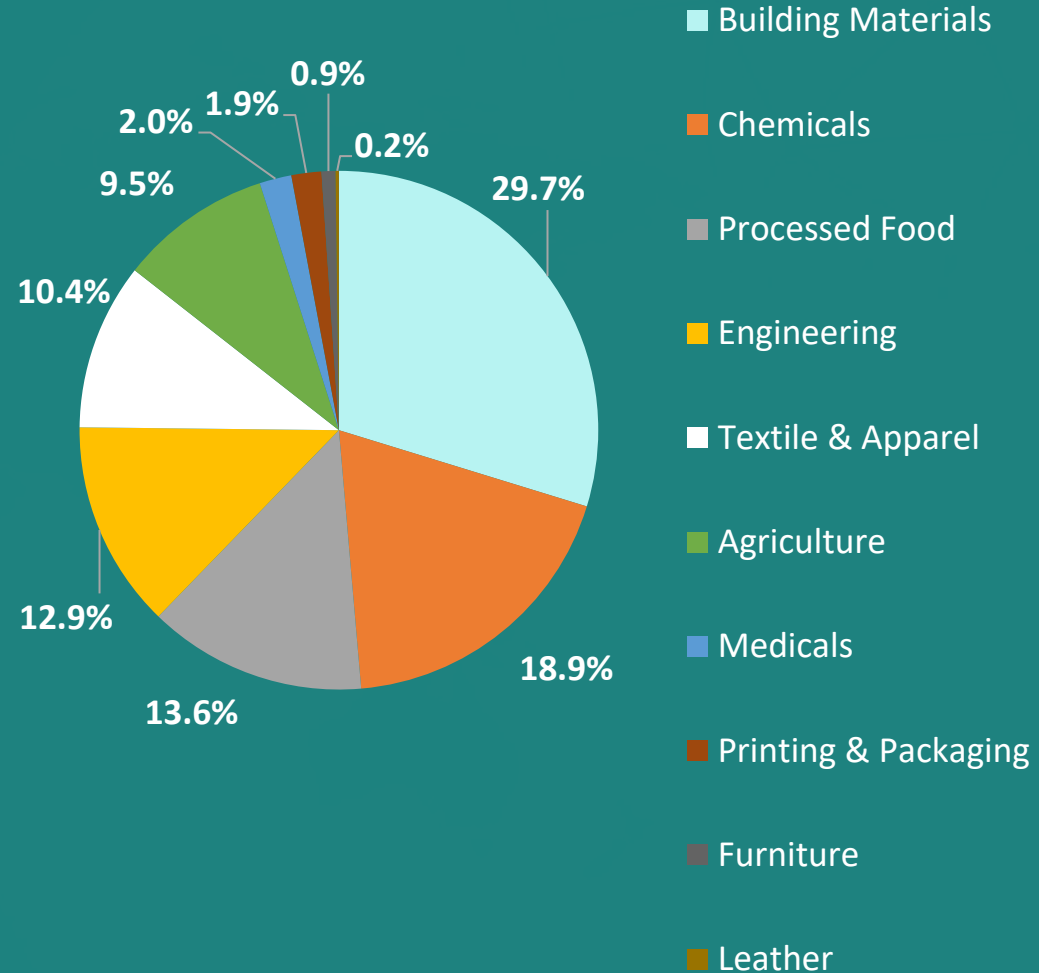
Sectorial Exports in 2025 (USD Billion)

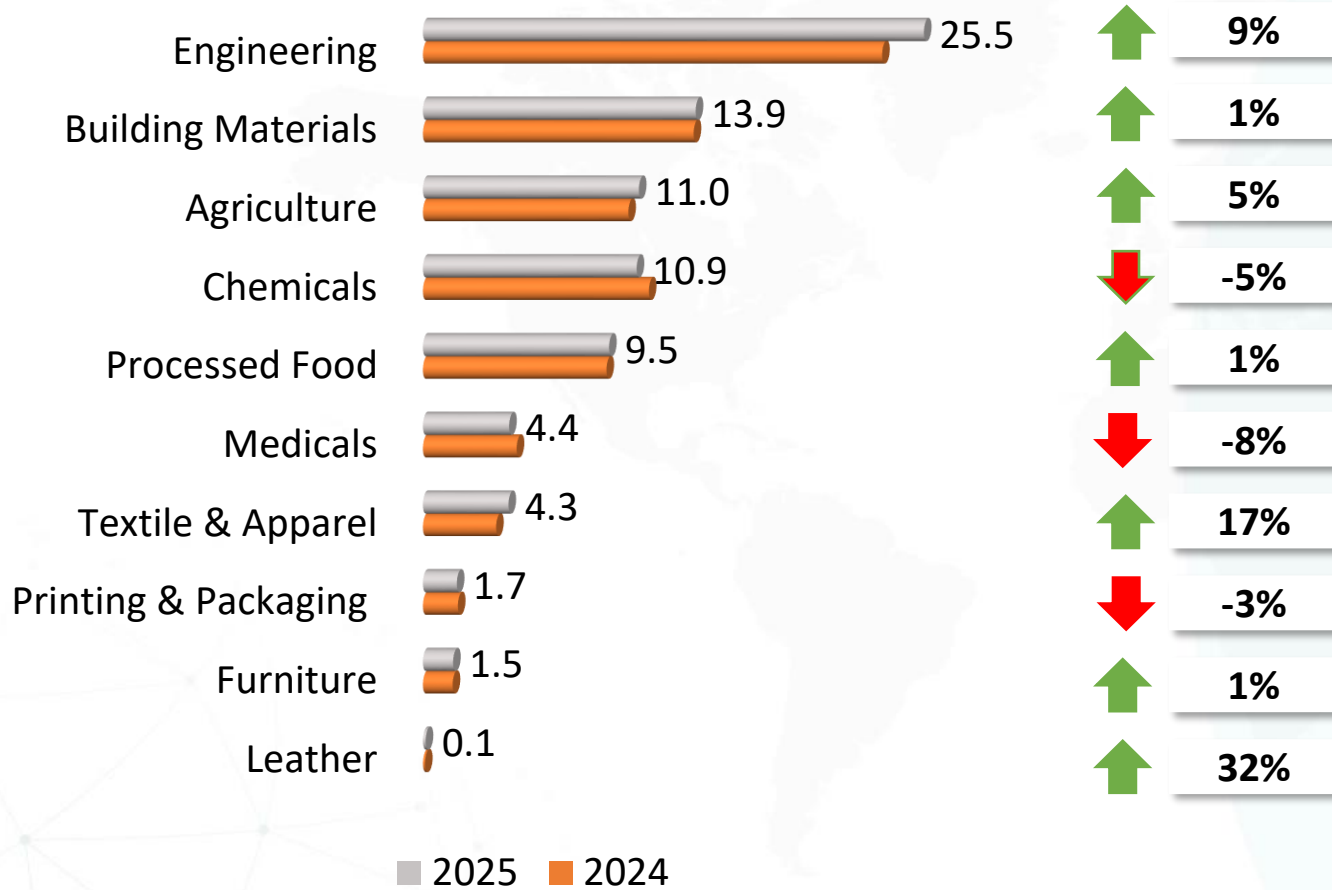

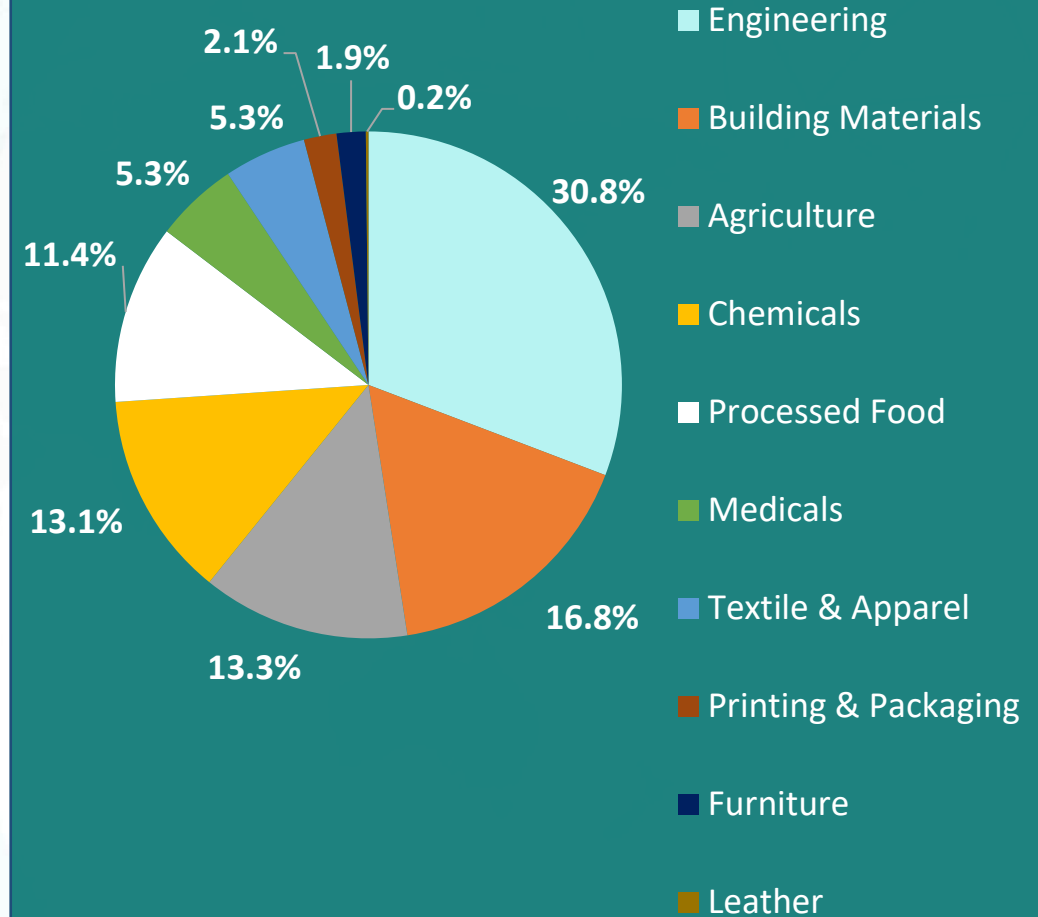
Sectorial Imports in 2025 (USD Billion)

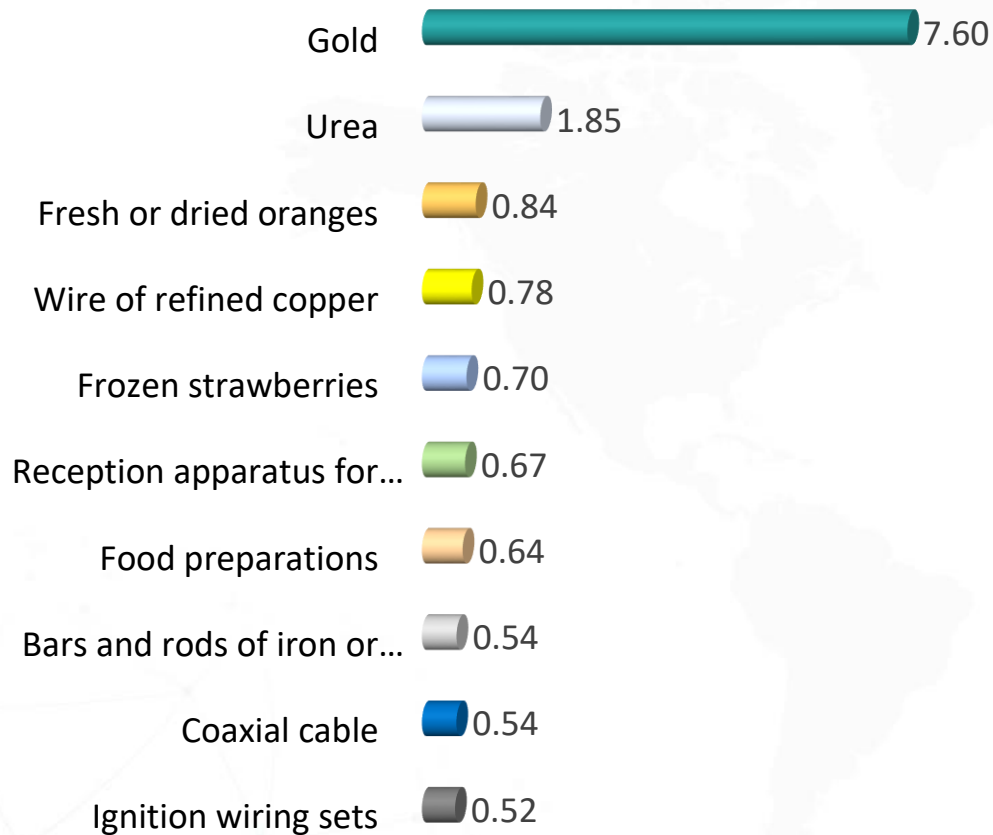

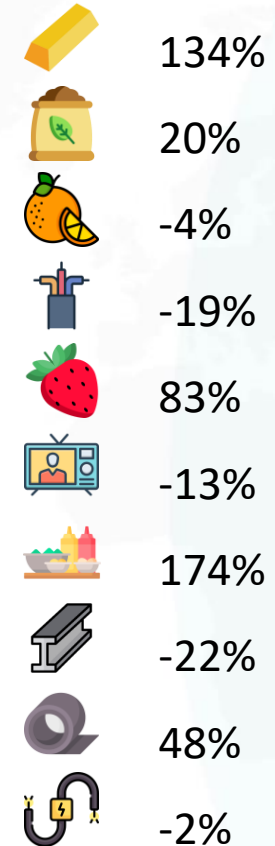

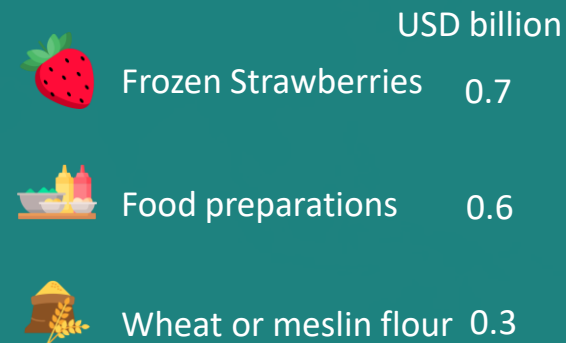

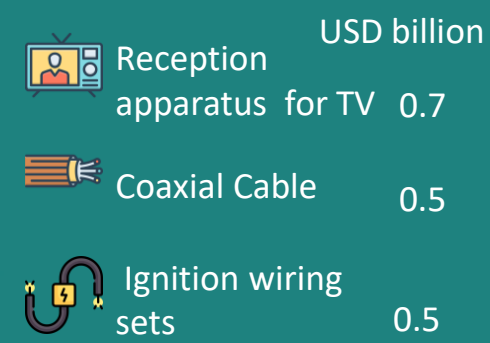

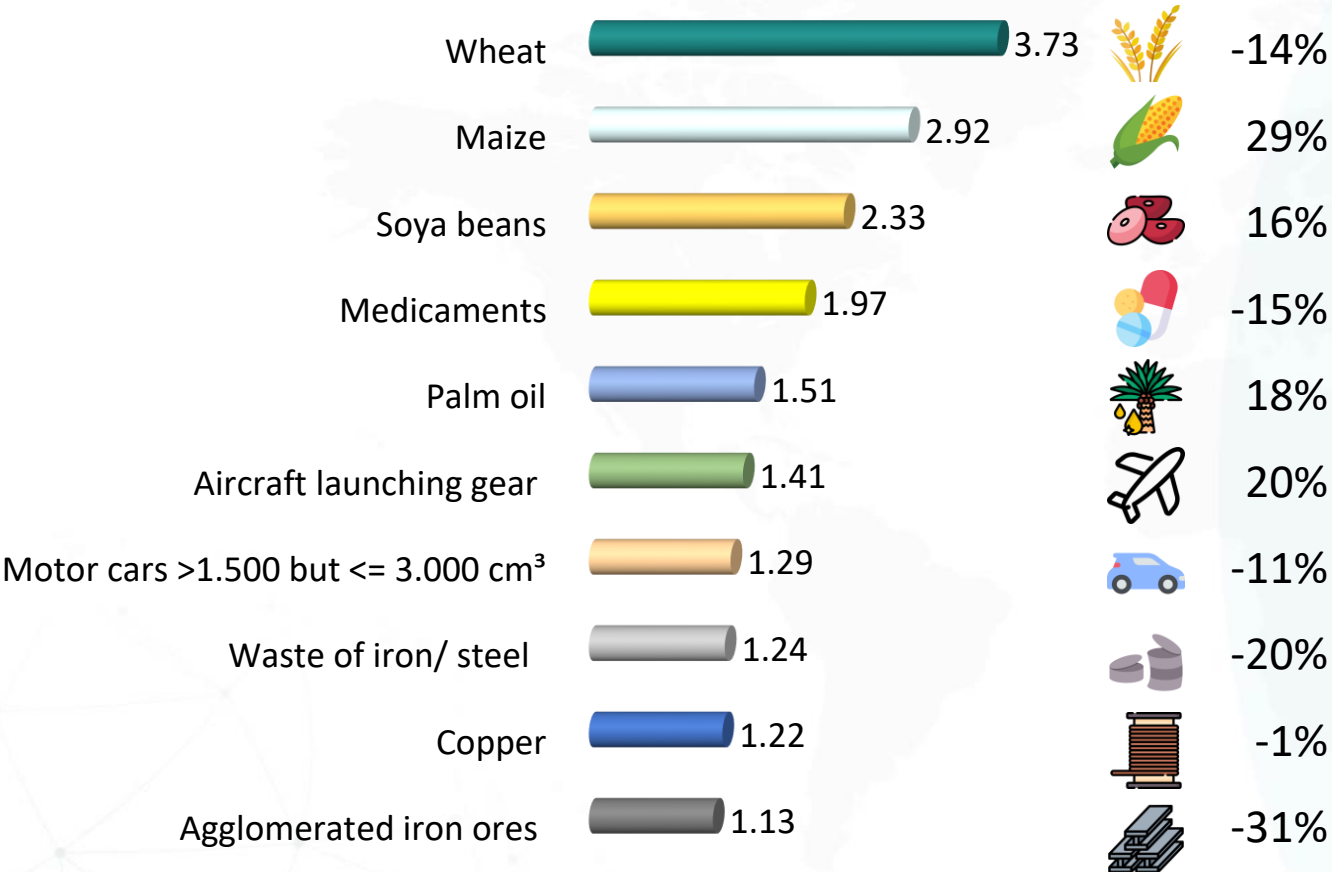

Top Imported Products in 2025 (USD Billion)

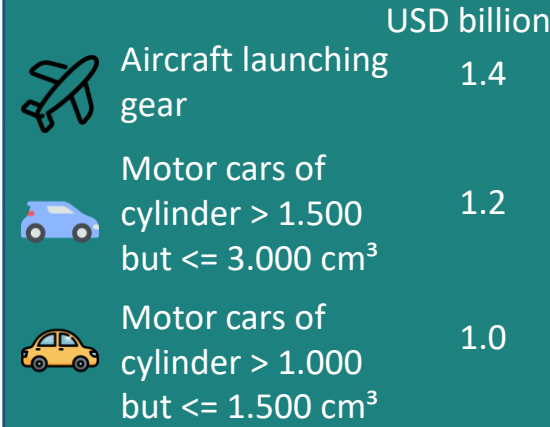

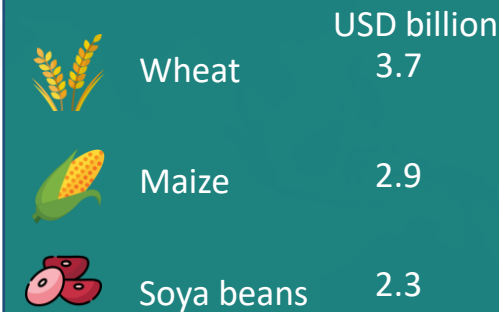

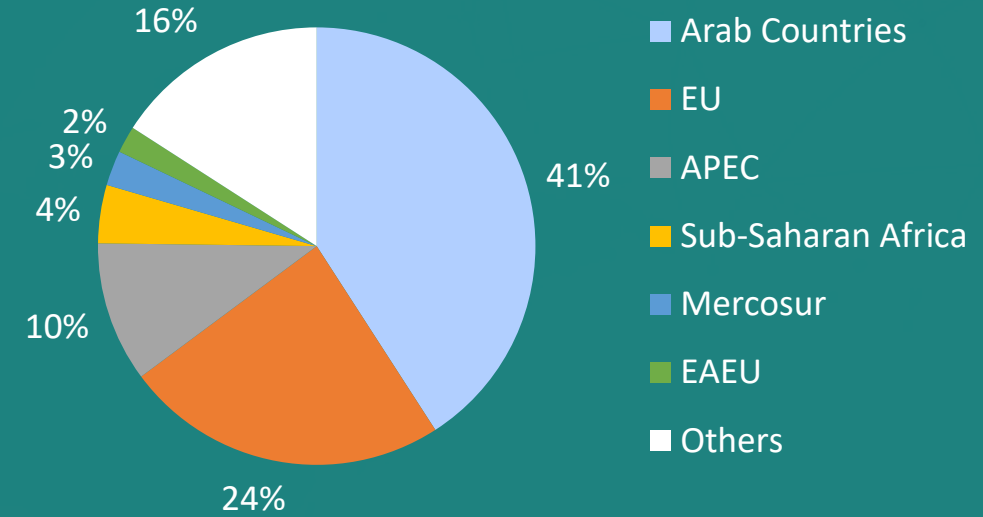

TOP IMPORTERS FROM EGYPT IN 2025



UAE's top imported products from Egypt in 2025 were Gold (83.4%), and reception apparatus for television (2.3%) with a value of USD 5.86 billion, and USD 0.16 billion, respectively.



Urea (7%) and Polypropylene (5.7%) are **Turkey's** top imported products from Egypt in 2025 with a value of USD 0.22 billion, and USD 0.18 billion, respectively.



Saudi Arabia mainly imported Wire of refined copper (12.6%) and T-shirts (6.6%) from Egypt in 2025 with a value of USD 0.38 billion, and USD 0.25 billion, respectively.

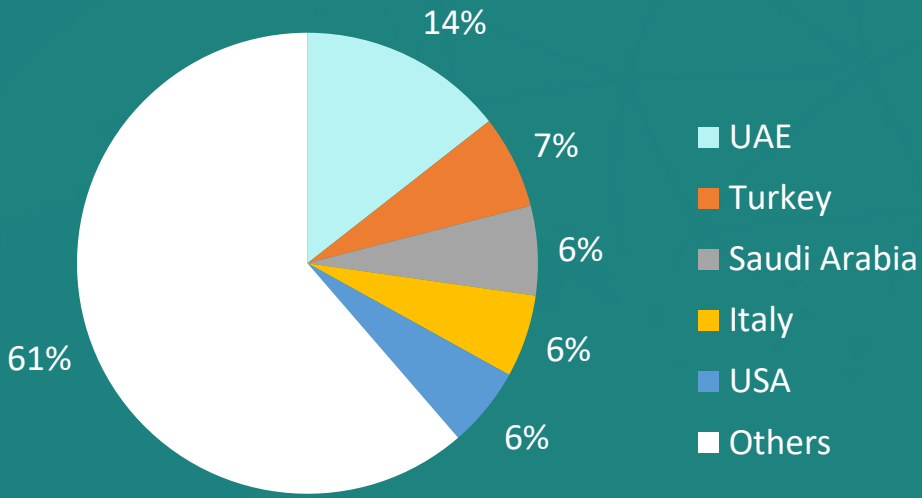


Urea (9.6%) and Aluminum, not alloyed (6.4%) are **Italy's** top imported products from Egypt in 2025 with a value of USD 0.27 billion, and USD 0.18 billion, respectively.



T-shirts of textiles (7.6%) and men's or boys' trousers of synthetic fibers (5.8%) are **USA's** top imported product from Egypt in 2025 with a value of USD 0.21 billion, and USD 0.16 billion, respectively.

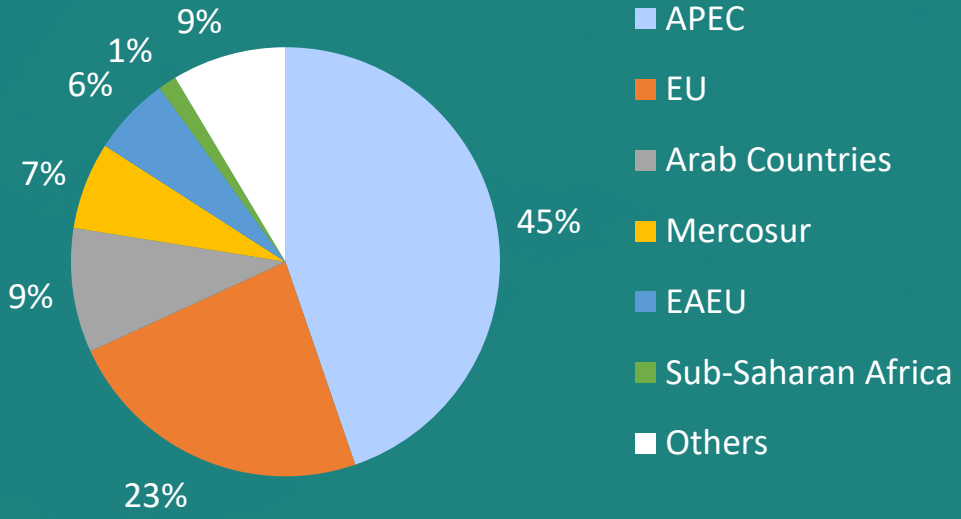

TOP EXPORERS TO EGYPT IN 2025



The top imported products from **China** are Parts of telephone sets (2.8%) and flat panel of display modules (2.4%), with a value of USD 0.52 billion, and USD 0.45 billion, respectively.



The top imported products from **USA** are soya beans (38.3%), and aircraft launching gear (9%) with a value of USD 1.99 billion, and USD 0.47 billion, respectively.



Egypt's top imported products from **Russia** are wheat (44.9%), and semi-finished products of iron or non-alloy steel (9.8%) with a value of USD 2.19 billion, and USD 0.48 billion, respectively.

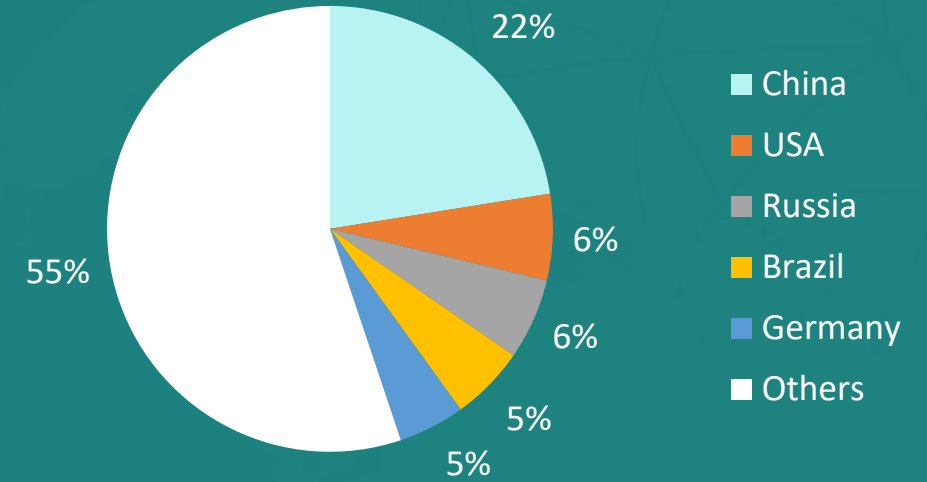


The top imported products from **Brazil** are maize (42.1%), and raw cane sugar (11.8%) with a value of USD 1.9 billion, and USD 0.53 billion, respectively.



The top imported products from **Germany** are road tractors for semi-trailers (7.9%) and medicaments (7.7%) with a value of USD 0.31 billion, and USD 0.31 billion, respectively.
